Why is fit a big deal?



Improperly fitting PPE can be dangerous.



Examples of risks: oversized gloves, loose clothing, tight gear.



Uncomfortable gear leads to non-compliance.



What's changing?

- New OSHA rules require PPE to fit every worker properly.
- Applies to all PPE: hard hats, gloves, safety glasses, fall protection gear.
- Employers must ensure proper fit, even for employee-provided gear.





How do you get it right?



- Check fit regularly.
- Work with trusted suppliers.
- Listen to your crew.
- Train your team on proper fit.
